





Subject: Safety





SUBJECT: SEAT BELT SAFETY

Target: All Ages

Description: A small wooden car with two seats, one with a seat belt, one without. The car goes down a ramp, crashing into a cement block. The egg without the seat belt goes flying. Site may need to provide the eggs, boiled eggs make less of a mess. (You must supply your own eggs.)

<u>Size:</u> 4' x 10" long ramp, car @ 6" x 10" x 8"

Helmet Safety





SUBJECT: Helmet Safety

Target: Children, Youth and Adults

Description: Only your imagination limits you in the use of the famous gelatin brain mold, a mold that you fill with gray or pink flavored gelatin to make a model of the brain. Flavors that give flesh-tone results include peach and watermelon when you add a few drops of green food coloring to darken, but you can use any color, adding one 12 oz. can of light evaporated skim milk with no more than .5 percent fat. For demonstrations it can be jiggled, dropped, smashed, eaten and more.


